

AbPrazole Plus (Omeprazole Plus) or AbPrazole (Omeprazole) + AbSucralfate (Sucralfate)



DESCRIPTION

Omeprazole is from the family of proton pump inhibitors (PPI's) that blocks secretion of acid. Omeprazole assists by reducing and neutralizing acid in the horse's stomach, which enables improved healing of existing ulcer damage.

The presence of a **probiotic** helps restore natural intestinal flora, leading to a more rapid recovery and increased nutrient absorption.

Each dose of omeprazole is effective for 24 hours.

Sucralfate is a cytoprotective agent used for the symptomatic treatment of equine gastric ulcer disease.

Each dose of sucralfate is effective for 6-8 hours.

When sucralfate is administered in conjunction with omeprazole, the sucralfate will coat the ulcer and reduce the occurrence of further acid damage.



EXAMPLE DOSAGE CALCULATOR

Example – Horse weight 1100lb (550kg)

Days	Omeprazole or Omeprazole Plus	Sucralfate
1-21	3 sachets/scoops once-a-day	3 sachets/scoops twice per day= 6 per day
22-30	3 sachets/scoops once-a-day	2 sachets/scoops twice per day= 4 per day
		*Prevention as required

Bundle can be customized based on your horse's weight.

- 725 - 950lb (330-430kg)
- 960 - 1250lb (440-570kg)
- 1275 - 1720lb (580-780kg)

HOW MANY DO I NEED?

Omeprazole (in conjunction with sucralfate)
Days 1 to 30 ONE sachet or scoop of omeprazole per 175kg (365lbs), administered as a single dose per day for 30 days
*Prevention: as required

Sucralfate
Days 22 to 30 : ONE sachet or scoop of sucralfate per 330kg (990lbs), administered as a single dose either three times (ideal) or twice per day for 7 days. *Prevention ongoing as required



COMPOSITION

Sucralfate: Each sachet or scoop of film-coated granules contains 5.0g of sucralfate BP.

Treatment dosage of 30mg/kg (13mg/lb) of horse's bodyweight.

Omeprazole: Each 2.8g sachet or scoop of enteric-coated granules contains 700mg Omeprazole BP

Omeprazole Plus: Each 4.2g sachet or scoop of enteric-coated granules contains 700mg Omeprazole BP, 21 Billion cfu probiotic B. coagulans (lactobacillus sporogenes)

Treatment dosage of 4.0mg/kg (1.8mg/lb) of horse's bodyweight.
Prevention dosage of 2.0mg/kg (0.9mg/lb) of horse's bodyweight.



FEEDING TIPS

Sucralfate is most effective when administered:

- In the morning when the stomach is less likely to be full.
- Minimum of 30 minutes prior to any other medications due to interactions.
- Twice-a-day dose - AM and PM

Feeding Tips

- Sprinkle onto a small feed (ie: a few handfuls of moistened chaff)
- Mix with water and administer via oral syringe
- Mix into a paste and smear onto apples or carrots

Important

- If a sucralfate dose is missed and the next planned dose is within a few hours, wait and administer as per the normal schedule.
- Do not double-dose.

Omeprazole or Omeprazole Plus granules:

Give once a day.

Feeding Tips

Mix with apple sauce, oil or spread on a treat.
Top dress to dry or damp feed. Do not soak in water.



DO NOT expose omeprazole products to water or the enteric coating and buffering agent (added to aid effectiveness), will be damaged.
